SPECIAL EVENT REQUEST / NCBA SIDEWALK SALE

A Special Events Application was submitted by the Northville Central Business Association (NCBA) to conduct their Annual Sidewalk Sale from July 17th – 19th in downtown Northville. The following was noted:

- Event hours are 10:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m.
- Merchants will set up tents, tables and racks on the sidewalk, allowing the required clearance for pedestrian traffic. Each business is responsible for clean up after the event.
- A certificate of insurance for \$1M general liability naming the City as additional insured with an Endorsement will need to be received by the City Clerk before the event. A Hold Harmless indemnifying the City of Northville has been received.

The NCBA noted that the annual sidewalk sale date was moved to accommodate other events. The date change should not impact the merchants. About 18-20 merchants are expected to participate.

Motion Ekong, seconded by McKindles to approve the request from the NCBA to conduct the Annual Sidewalk Sale in Downtown Northville from July 17 –19, 2015 as outlined above. **Motion carried unanimously.**
