**CITY COUNCIL SPECIAL MEETING MINUTES**  
**December 29, 2016**

Mayor Roth called the meeting to order with the Pledge of Allegiance at 5:00 p.m. in the City of Northville Municipal Building, City Council Chambers, 215 W. Main Street, Northville, Michigan, 48167.

**1. ROLL CALL**

**3. APPROVAL OF AGENDA**

**Motion Allen, seconded by Ekong** to approve the agenda as presented. **Motion carried unanimously.**

**4. RATIFICATION OF COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENTS**

Contracts with the City's four bargaining units expire December 31, 2016. Tentative Agreements were reached with AFSCME (American Federation of State, County, and Municipal Employees), MAPE (Michigan Association of Public Employees), and POAM (Police Officers Association of Michigan).

AFSCME and MAPE have ratified their tentative agreements. POAM is expected to ratify its tentative agreement in early January 2017.

**Motion Allen, seconded by Ekong** to recess the special meeting to go into Closed Session for the purpose of discussing strategy connected to the collective bargaining agreements. **Roll Call Vote. Yes: Allen, Darga, Ekong, Price, Roth. No: None. Motion carried unanimously.**

Meeting recessed at 5:02 p.m. Meeting reconvened at 5:51 p.m.

**Motion Allen, seconded by Price** to ratify the 2017-2020 tentative collective bargaining agreement with AFSCME and authorize the Mayor and Clerk to sign the agreement. **Motion carried unanimously.**

**Motion Allen, seconded by Ekong** to ratify the 2017-2020 tentative collective bargaining agreement with MAPE and authorize the Mayor and Clerk to sign the agreement. **Motion carried unanimously.**
