## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

In accordance with the City of Northville's Liquor Management Ordinance (Chapter 5, Article II of the Code of Ordinances), the City of Northville's Liquor License Review Committee will hold a public hearing on Monday, April 5, 2021 at 6:00 p.m.

The Liquor Management Ordinance requires a public hearing and local government approval in the event of any new liquor license, transfer of ownership of a liquor license or application for a new permit. The purpose of this public hearing will be to solicit public comment on the following application:

Application to transfer membership interest by adding new member Charles Pankratz: and as a result, existing member Kevin DeGroot will hold 29% membership interest and new member Charles Pankratz will hold 22% membership interest, in conjunction with 2020 Micro Brewer licensed company with On Premise Tasting Room Permit and Outdoor Service (1 area) located at 410 N. Center St. Northville, MI 48167, Wayne County.
