OFFICES TO BE FILLED

- Mayor – One to be elected for 2-year term
- Councilmember – Two to be elected for 4-year terms

QUALIFICATIONS FOR OFFICE

Pursuant to City Charter Section 5.1:

- Resident of the City of Northville for at least 2 years immediately prior to July 20, 2021.
- Qualified and registered elector on July 20, 2021.
- Not in default to the City nor to any governmental unit of the State of Michigan.
- May not be an incumbent in any elective City office for which the term of said office does not expire with the November 2, 2021 City Election. An incumbent whose term does not expire with the November 2, 2021 Election, must resign their elective office prior to filing.

Candidates that hold another elective office and have questions about incompatible offices must contact their legal counsel. The City Clerk's office does not give legal advice.

WHAT TO FILE

All candidates file the following documents. The City Charter does not provide the option to pay a filing fee in lieu of filing nominating petitions.

- **Nominating Petitions** (City/Township Nonpartisan)
- **Affidavit of Eligibility**
- **Affidavit of Identity and Receipt of Filing**
- **Consent of Candidate** (required if someone other than candidate submits the filing to the Clerk)

PETITION COPIES: Make copies of your signed petitions before you file. Copies will not be provided when you file.

WHEN AND WHERE TO FILE

Filing Deadline: No later than **4:00 pm on Tuesday, July 20, 2021**

You may submit your filing earlier than the filing deadline. Filing earlier may allow extra time to submit a supplemental nominating petition filing (if applicable) by the filing deadline.
