POLICE OFFICER

The City of Northville is located on the west side of both Oakland and Wayne counties and is situated in both counties. The Oakland County portion is surrounded by the City of Novi. The Wayne County portion is surrounded by Northville Township. Northville is served by Northville Public Schools. The city is located 21 miles northeast of Ann Arbor and 29 miles northwest of Detroit. The population was 5,970 at the 2010 census and the city is approximately two square miles in area.

The City of Northville has a very lively downtown with an active Downtown Development Authority. Also, it is home to one of the few remaining horseracing tracks in the State. It has a City Manager form of government that encourages participation from its residents and business owners.

2019 Starting salary is \$53,123.20 with top pay being \$68,619.20 after four years. There is a 10 percent educational bonus for a Bachelor's Degree and a 5 percent educational bonus for an Associate Degree when the officer reaches top pay. This includes an excellent benefit package.

The Department currently consists of a Chief, Captain, three Sergeants and eight Police Officers. The Department contracts for Dispatch and Lock-up services from Northville Township. The Department is currently looking to fill one full-time police officer position.

The Department requires applicants to have a minimum of an Associate Degree in law enforcement or a related field, be MCOLES certifiable, and be at least 21 years of age. Applicants will be selected by an oral board and should be prepared to undergo a comprehensive background investigation, credit check, and psychological examination. The chosen applicant must meet all MCOLES requirements, complete a Field Training Program and a one year probationary period.

The City of Northville is an ADA / EOE employer.
